**** Managers - Please communicate the following to your players.**

1. All early games must start no later than 7:00 sharp!!! The 'Clock' starts running at 7:00!
2. One and a half hour time limits on games. No inning of the 1st game will start after 8:30 unless tied. No inning of the 2nd game will start after one and a half hour of play unless tied. If tied when time expires, the last out from the previous inning will be placed at 2nd base at the start of the succeeding innings. The game will continue until a winner is determined. There should be no "tied" games
3. Extra inning games - Same rules as #2 starting in 8th inning.
4. Eight run rule in effect after 5 innings of play.
5. The second team listed on the schedule is home team.

6. In all league games, each team is to provide a new ball.
 7. The **Dudley red stitch optic yellow** polycore ball (WT-12Y 4A 147Y FP-.47 Cor; 375 Comp) will be used in the State tournament. This ball is recommended for all league games.
 8. Keep the fields and dugouts clean! Please pick up all garbage and trash around the bleachers, fields and parking lots.
 9. No cars are to be driven past the paved parking lot. This is a direct order from the Farmington Park & Rec.
 10. After the 2nd game is complete, the home team of the second game is responsible for shutting off the lights and filling in the holes at the batters box and pitching rubber. A rake should be available at the field.
 11. League entry fee is due by **May 17th!** (Please submit ASAP)!
 12. Team rosters are due by **June 7th.** (Please submit as soon as possible.) Twenty players is the maximum. Names and complete addresses are required. Only players on your rosters will be allowed to play in the State Tournament.
 13. The rescheduling of rainouts is the responsibility of the **managers** of the teams involved. After a date has been agreed upon by the teams involved, the league director should be notified so that the ballfield can be reserved with the city and umpires scheduled.
- Note:** Due to the "many" games scheduled this season, the availability of field #1 is very limited. **In addition, on our "open" nights there may be rescheduled slowpitch games or youth girl fastpitch games on field #1.** Therefore, very few open nights are available later in the summer. Monday nights will be the best option/alternative. **Makeups will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Reserve Fields soon.** Other alternatives include:
1. Friday Makeup games - generally the field is available, except the night before tournaments;
 2. Field #2 is available July 30 - Aug 9.

 15. Helmets are required for all batters and base runners.
